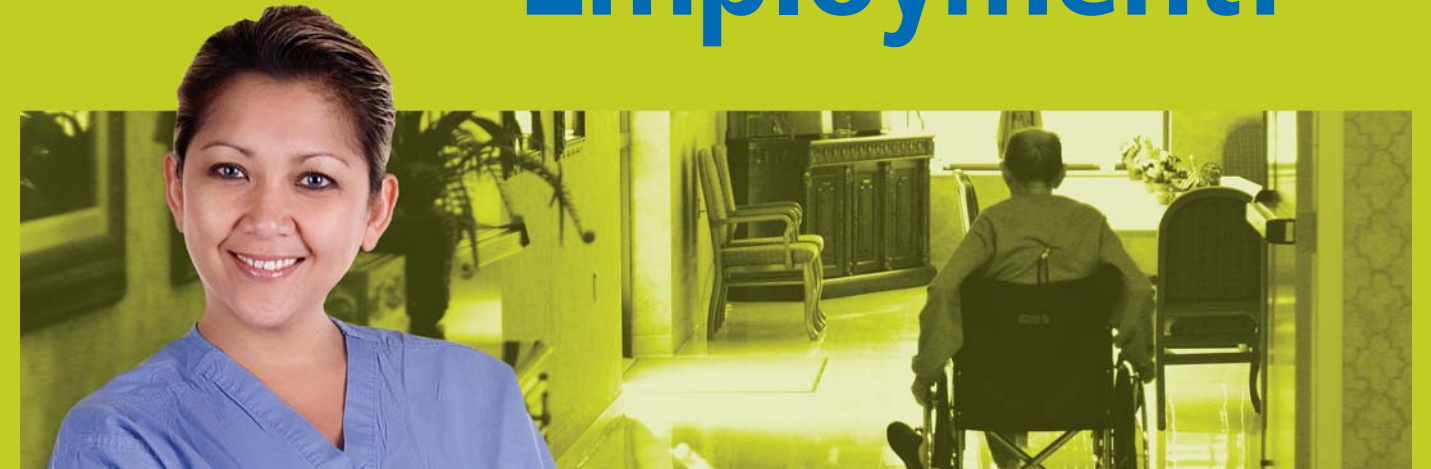

What Kind of Jobs?

Drake Medox grads qualify for a number of different roles and job titles. These include:

- Resident Care Attendant
- Community Health Worker
- Long Term Care Aide (Geriatric)
- Home Healthcare Worker
- Assisted Living Worker
- Home Support Worker
- Personal Service Assistant
- Live-In Caregiver
- Companion

You will become a support for people with health challenges, so in the course of a day you might help to feed people who are unable to feed themselves, dress them and take them outside, transport them, groom them, help with toileting needs and bathing, and provide an opportunity for socializing!

After graduation, if you accept the guaranteed offer of employment with our sister company, Drake Medox Health Services, you will be employed in the role of a "Community Health Worker", which means that you often work directly in the homes of people who need assistance managing some of their activities of daily living. Mostly you would be working with the elderly, but there are also children, young adults and families who will require your support services.

Admission Requirements

- Grade 12 graduation or equivalent
- Proof of a negative TB skin test
- Criminal Record Search demonstrating the absence of a relevant criminal record. Applicant is responsible for any costs incurred. Conviction for relevant offences may preclude acceptance into the program.
- One professional reference.
- Physicians medical/fitness report
- Ability to speak and write in English
- Successful completion of interview for program acceptance
- Written response outlining why the applicant wants to take the program (150 words or less)
- Two passport-size colour photos.
- Successful completion of Prior Learning Assessment (for ACCELERATED program only)

- Band/Aboriginal Funding

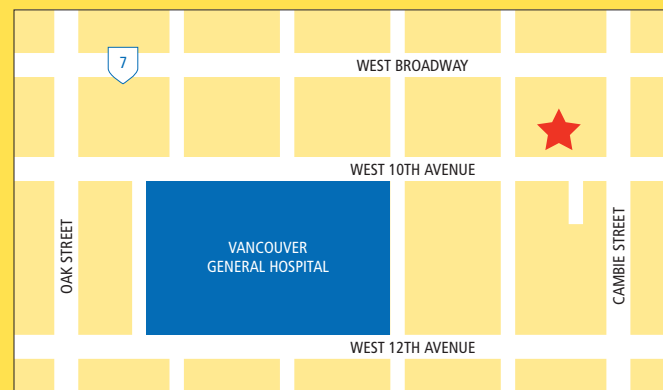
